OPEN SWINE SHOW

Saturday, July 20th, 2024

Registration closes @ 3:30pm / Declare weights by 3:30pm

Show begins @ 5:00pm

1. All exhibitors will be charged the gate admission upon arrival. Exhibitors can purchase fair admission at fcfair.org. Admission tickets purchased through the fair website (Hometown Ticketing) will be issued a QR code that will be scanned at the fair entrance.
2. Entries:
 - A. Entry options:
 - Register ONLINE by midnight July 18, 2024.
 - Register by MAIL (mail must be **received** by July 18, 2024).
 - Day of show registration. Must be registered by 3:30pm. Day of show registration adds a \$10.00 market show late fee per exhibitor.
 - B. Entry fees:
 - Entry fee of \$20.00 per entry / head.
 - Showmanship fee is \$10.00 per entry / exhibitor. (No late fee charge on showmanship classes)
 - Late fee of \$10.00 per exhibitor for market registrations after July 18, 2024.
3. No health papers required if born within the State of Ohio. Animals crossing State / Country borders will require health papers. All animals are subject to inspection by the fair vet.
4. All entries must be on the fairgrounds by 3:30pm on show day.
5. All Junior Fair pigs will use weights from official fair weigh in. All outside entries declare weights **within 10 pounds**. Scale will be available. Declared weights will be asked to weigh hogs if placed 1st or 2nd in class. Junior fair animals are exempt from weigh backs since animals were certified at the start of the fair.
6. No exhibitor shall be permitted to collect more than two (2) premiums in any one class. Only market hogs will be shown, no breeding classes.
7. Upon request open swine exhibitors may be provided with one (1) pen for every two (2) hogs as space is available. This is on a first come, first serve basis. After all pens are occupied, remaining exhibitors will be required to show from their trailers. No tack pens are available.

8. Junior Fair exhibitors will not be given any extra pen space. If a Junior Fair exhibitor feels they require additional pen space for open class entries, you will need to contact the open livestock committee for approval.
9. No animals may be shown in any class other than the class in which that animal is assigned.
10. All entries must check in with the clerk at the entrance of the show arena.
11. No boars or sows.
12. Weight classes will be determined on the day of the show.
13. All market hogs must have been owned by the exhibitor for at least thirty days before the show.
14. Exhibitors are to furnish their own bedding.
15. All market hogs entered in Jr. Fair must stay on exhibit until 11:00 pm on the last day of the fair.
16. Non Jr. Fair exhibitor entries may leave the grounds at the conclusion of the show.
17. Premiums will NOT be paid out on the day of show. Premiums will be mailed within 60 days as long as proper paperwork is completed.
18. Franklin County Fair is governed by the Ohio Livestock Health and Tampering Exhibition Rules. (Chapter 901-18 & 19).
19. All exhibitors will abide by the rules and regulations set in place by the Franklin County Fair.
20. Any class ties will follow the Senior Fair Board procedures on file.

LATE Registration - Market Swine Entry Class – \$10.00 late fee per exhibitor

Section 02: SWINE SHOWMANSHIP

1. Entry fee for showmanship classes only is \$10.00 per entry / person. (No late fees if just entering showmanship.)
2. Overall winners from each of the four showmanship classes will receive a \$25.00 premium, as well as a banner.
3. Showmanship classes will start promptly at 5:00pm and will precede the Open Class Swine Show.

Class 2	Showmanship – Intermediate (age 14-16)
Class 3	Showmanship – Junior (age 9-13)
Class 4	Showmanship – Peewee (5-8)
